to do further research into fees associated with Construction and Demolition Debris Recycling imposed by other government agencies around the country.

On 10/27/2020, staff presented an overview of Construction and Demolition Debris (C&D) recycling in the community.

On 12/08/2020, staff presented recommendations regarding minimum recycling percentages and fees related to compliance with the ordinance.

The Zero Waste Subcommittee requested further investigation and recommendations into the fees related to compliance with the C&D recycling.

Staff will make a presentation that includes a review of policies in other communities and discuss how fees are structured.

Discussion to Request Single-Use of Plastic Accessories (B)

Explanation: On December 8, 2020, staff presented information to the Zero Waste Subcommittee about the single-use of plastics in the Gainesville community.

At the request of the Zero Waste Subcommittee, staff reviewed policies regarding the regulation of single-use plastic accessories around the

country. Staff researched the concept of restaurants and food service locations charging for single-use of plastic accessories for items such as utensils and cups. At this meeting, staff will report findings and provide recommendations to the Zero Waste Subcommittee.

Additionally, the City Attorney will provide an update to address the legal aspects of this concept.

Fiscal Note: There is no fiscal impact associated with this item.

Update on Exclusive Collection Contract (B)

Explanation: Staff will provide additional information and options concerning the implementation of electric garbage trucks in the new solid waste collection contract.

At the October 13, 2020 Subcommittee Meeting, staff gave a presentation on the benefits of an exclusive solid waste contract for commercial garbage, multifamily garbage, recycling, and bulk waste, and curbside garbage, recycling, bulk waste, and yard waste

At the January 5, 2021 Subcommittee Meeting, staff presented an update on features of the solicitation that are intended to improve service and assist in reaching Zero Waste goals.

The Subcommittee expressed concerns about the specifications that require the vendor to implement the exclusive use of electric garbage trucks within three years of the start of the agreement. Staff will present possible alternatives to the Subcommittee.

Additionally, staff indicated that data was being finalized by consultant We Are Neutral to quantify the reduction in greenhouse gases that would be emitted with an exclusive contract serviced by compressed natural gas vehicles. We Are Neutral has also determined the additional reduction in greenhouse gases that would be achieved with an all-electric fleet. We Are Neutral will present their findings.

Fiscal Note: There is no fiscal impact associated with this item.

RECOMMENDATION Zero Waste Subcommittee 1) hear the presentation; and 2) provide direction to staff as deemed appropriate.
