*Explanation: The City was awarded a grant from the United States Department of Agriculture Community Compost and Food Waste Reduction Project.*

*The USDA grant is, in part, to determine the fiscal viability of using community composters to collect food waste curbside.*

*The USDA grant and Pilot food waste project was awarded in the amount of \$68,000. The Grantor will reimburse up to 75% of the expended amount (up to \$51,000.) Matching funds are identified in the Solid Waste Undesignated Fund Balance.*

*Community Builders will provide an update on the project six months into collection operations.*

*Fiscal Note: There is no fiscal impact associated with this update.*
